- Calculator with √ (square root) and exponent functions (TI-30IIX or TI-83 Plus are recommended)
- Put name on calculator!
- Pack of 5 section separators for binder

FOR SOCIAL STUDIES:

- Black 3 ring binder with clear cover and folder pockets inside
- Filler paper for binder
- Dividers for binder

FOR SCIENCE:

- Green 3 ring binder with clear cover and folder pockets inside
- pencils

FOR ART:

pencils!

FOR LANGUAGE ARTS:

- Red 1 inch 3 ring binder
- Filler paper for binder
- Dividers for binder
- 5 pack multi-colored highlighters

FOR PE:

- sneakers
- bathing suit

FOR READING class:

- 1 subject spiral notebook (70 pages or more)
- reading book for silent reading

FOR WORLD LANGUAGE:

- 1 subject spiral notebook

IN GENERAL:

- a folder marked as "Homework Folder"
- pens and PENCILS- for use in all classes
- small pencil sharpener that will collect shavings
- pen/pencil pouch large enough for your calculator

The school will provide the assignment planner on the first day of school.

- 2. If you plan to participate in a sport this fall (soccer, field hockey, football, cross country), you will need a current physical exam. You can go to your regular physician for an exam, or you can schedule a physical with the school doctor.
- 3. Information about **school pictures** will be sent home once school starts.
- 4. And...as you plan for your first day of school outfit, please remember the Great Falls Middle School guidelines for school appropriate dress:
 - Wear clothing that <u>completely covers all undergarments</u>.
 - Wear clothing that is not torn and fits properly so as not to create a safety hazard.
 - Wear tops and bottoms that meet, even when your arms are raised.
 - Shoulders and midriff should be covered front and back.
 - If you wear shorts or skirts, be sure that they are of a respectful length.
 - Hats and other forms of headgear such as bandanas and headbands are not to be worn in the school building at any time.
 - No colognes or perfumes or strongly scented deodorants, but regular and unscented deodorants are encouraged.
